One of the most common questions when wind farms comes to end of their life is - **what happens to the blades and other components of old turbines?**

Up to 90% of a wind turbine is recyclable with a lot of components made of materials such as steel and concrete, which can be recycled conventionally.

In line with our commitment to environmental stewardship, we are liaising with organisations who provide commercial, scalable solutions for the recycling of decommissioned wind turbine blades. This ensures sustainable reuse or repurpose rather than sent to landfill.
